The Community Arts Council of Prince George is challenging our local City Council, MLAs, Fire Department and local media celebrities to a Celebrity Chili Cook-off at our Annual Spring Arts Bazaar Saturday, June 11th 2011.

We supply the browned hamburger and sliced onions as per food safe guidelines. Your team will supply your secret ingredients (vegetables, canned beans, canned tomato sauce etc.), spices and assemble the chili. Please note that any fresh ingredients must be purchased within 24 hours of the event and stored in a refrigerator below 4 degrees, prepared in the kitchen at Studio 2880 and receipts must be available. ***Your recipe should be enough to make 70-100 sample size servings.***

Please have your team at the Studio 2880 Arts Complex by 10:00 a.m. on Saturday, June 11th to begin assembling and cooking your chili. The Community Arts Council of Prince George will provide all cooking utensils and basic supplies. Costumes or uniforms add colour to the event so be sure to wear yours!

Each bowl of chili will be served in a hand-thrown, hand-painted bowl designed by members of the Prince George Potter's Guild. The price for the bowl is only \$15.00 and the purchaser can sample each team's chili and vote for their favourite! We will have a volunteer selling the bowls - your team will "create" and serve!

The Celebrity Chili Cook-off is one of many activities organized for this fundraiser and community event. We will have a full range of fun activities for the whole family, including: an Art Market, kids activity tent, entertainment, silent art auction, community art project and much, much more! The arts complex grounds will be filled with artists demonstrating and selling their work.

Please be aware that this is a fundraiser for the Community Arts Council and Prince George Potter's Guild so as long as chili is being served the fundraiser will continue until 4:00.

Chili on a more serious note...

The Spring Arts Bazaar and Chili Cook Off is one of the major fundraisers for the Community Arts Council and the Prince George Potter's Guild. The chili bowls are the central and major part of this fundraiser. With the cuts that have happened in the arts sector our fundraisers play an even more vital role in the survival of the CAC and Potter's Guild. In short we would like to sell 350 chili bowls and would be thrilled if we could dip into our "bowl reserves" and sell 400 bowls. This being said the bowls do not sell without the chili, which is why the teams need to make enough chili for 70-100 samples.

The chili servings do not have to fill a whole bowl; they are samples of your culinary prowess. Having cooked for 100+ people I know how difficult it is to convert your favourite recipe into one to be enjoyed by the masses. Here are a few quantities for making large amounts of chili that might help you:

- Hamburger 15-20 lbs
- Kidney beans (canned) 10-14 lbs
- Crushed Tomatoes 8-10 lbs
- Tomato Paste 1 lb
- Onions 10-12
- Peppers 15-18
- Secret ingredients to taste

While every recipe is different and quantities will vary based on how much of each ingredient you need (whether you make a vegetarian on one that has more beans than meat or vice versa), we recommend that you have enough ingredients to make 3 large pots of chili.

Thank you for your interest in the 2011 Chili Cook Off and supporting the Community Arts Council and the Potter's Guild in our annual Spring fundraiser. Without your support this fundraiser wouldn't be a success. As a show of our appreciation each team will be listed on our website and promotional material as a supporter of the event. Any promotional material, banners, buttons, stickers etc. are more than welcome as you serve your chili.
